The next meeting will be Wednesday, July 11. Bring your lunch. Drinks and dessert are provided.

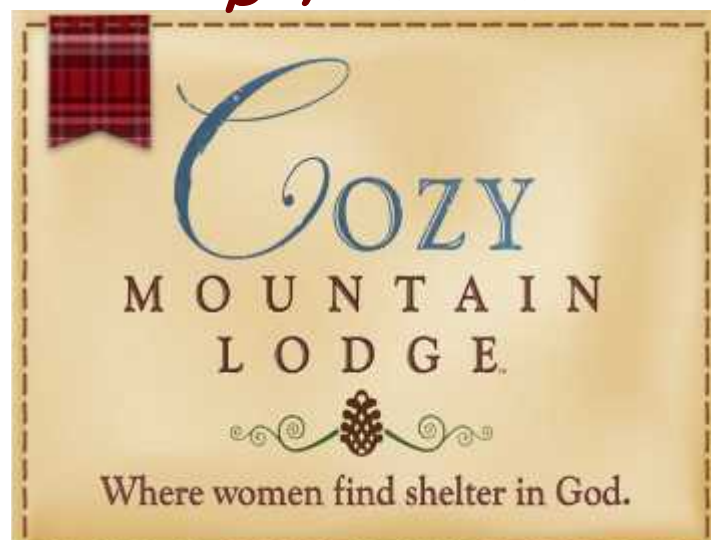
Prayer Shawl
