

Mother Daughter Spring Banquet



There were over 100 quilts displayed at the banquet, and a good time was had by all. Jody Graeler took us back in time through the history of quilt making: back to the early days of Egypt, to wagon travel over the prairies, and to today's mission work of the Linus Project Organization. Janet Kolmer told us about the handmade blankets that are given to infants and children/teens, made to share warmth and comfort to children who are ill, traumatized or with other needs, usually in hospitals. In 2017, our St. Paul's Linus Project Gals made 72 blankets to distribute locally.



Mission Team Updates

Your St. Paul's Mission Team has had a busy winter and like everyone else is looking forward to spring and summer! The team has met with several missionaries recently to learn about their ministries and consider them for future support. Interviews, fact finding and prayer are always part of the process in determining whether to add missionaries or organizations to the list of those to whom St. Paul's provides funding. We consider many factors, including how the mission work fits into some of the focus areas for St. Paul's mission support, the level of support already achieved and the long-term viability of the mission. The Mission Team also considers short term mission work by our St. Paul's members for support.

The team would like to introduce you to two new missionary couples that we have added to the St. Paul's supported missionaries in 2018:

David & Shawna Boerema: Many of you will remember David & Shawna from their time in youth ministry at St. Paul's. They visited with the congregation last fall to talk about their new ministry with EFCA Reach Global as a part of the Apex team. Apex supports high school and college students in living and ministering in other cultures in community and partnership with local Christians and churches. David & Shawna are working with high school groups to set up summer ministry trips in urban areas. They report that there are seven groups planning ministry in Los Angeles, Detroit, Kansas City, Baltimore and Washington, DC this summer. They would love to have five more groups. David & Shawna report that they have achieved 100 percent support and they are 100 percent stretched! You can learn more about their ministry at apexmissions.org.

Nick & Erica are serving along with their two girls in North Africa bringing the Gospel to college students. They are focused on engaging with the students, building relationships and sharing the Gospel while discipling those that express a desire to follow Jesus. Their mission is to see lost students transformed into lifelong, Christ-centered laborers and their vision is to see 50,000 multiplying disciples in the North Africa, Middle East region by 2020.

In addition to meeting with missionaries the team is busy in several other ways. A new brochure has been drafted that provides information on the missionaries and organizations supported by St. Paul. We are also working to update the Missions page on the St. Paul's website. We will be helping **Edie Lewis** (EFCA Reach Global) by providing craft supplies that she can use in her training work with the wives of Pastors overseas.

We are planning the summer and fall visits and presentations by some of our missionaries as well as the next Food Drive.
