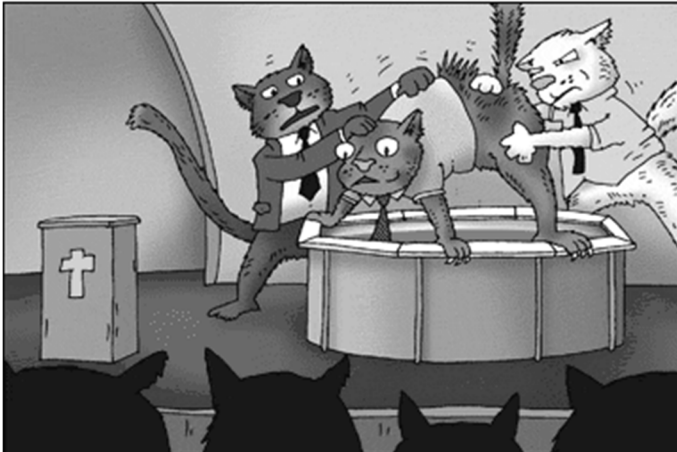
Stitch-in, Tuesday, February 19, 9:00 a.m.
