Update on Marissa

As many of you know, Marissa (Philippines) is being treated for bone cancer. The following was received from the CPMT office. "...since her case is metastatic in nature and aggressive tumor forming, the doctor recommends a maintenance of Herceptin and bone strengthener over 21 days...If she stops the treatment, the tumors will recur." These treatments will take place every 21 days at a cost of approximately \$2,100 each. St. Paul's Mission Team will be sending \$1,000 to partially cover one treatment.
