## **St. Paul's White Cross Ministry Increases Help**

Our Stitch In group (now White Cross Ministry) has expanded its focus to include making book bags as well as dresses and shorts. Each kit includes the pattern cut out in fabric, pins, needles and scissors. Sewing classes are offered to teach how to complete a garment or book bag.

When this ministry was getting started, I asked our congregation for necessary supplies to make dresses and shorts. You very graciously gave us those supplies and kept us motivated in our sewing! For the new kits, we have all the necessary items needed except fabric scissors. If you have a pair of fabric scissors you are not using, I know where there is a need and ask you to consider donating them to our ministry. ## **Spring "In-Gathering"**

May 8th will be Woman's Fellowship's Spring "In-Gathering" supporting Nurses for Newborns. This is a home visitation program which provides a safety net for families to prevent infant mortality, child abuse, an neglect. Specially trained pediatric nurses are sent to the homes of pregnant women or parents with infants who face medical, social or environmental risks. There will be a collection box in the Welcome Center, beginning April 10th to place your donations. New or gently used items needed: infant clothing newborn to 2T, receiving blankets, bibs, wash cloths, bath towels, etc. New baby care items needed: lotions, bottles, bottle brushes, pacifiers, etc. Especially needed are diapers (all sizes) and wipes (unscented preferred). Thank you for helping us reach out to those in need.

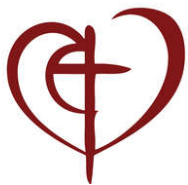
