Deacons Report by Charlie Jung

The Deacons met on June 10, 2019. We opened with prayer followed by approval of May's Financial Report.

- We discussed custodial help needs and was advised they were in the process of being taken care with hiring help for Clay to cover his vacation time and days he is not working.
- The 920 Warson house was discussed regarding the problem with the gas meter and needed repairs. It was also decided, after our contract payment runs out, we will discontinue with the alarm system.
- Requirements to repair the hail damage to the Church building was discussed as some of the estimates from contractors exceeded insurance adjusters claim.
- We are looking into Health Insurance needs for 2020 as the number of those covered will be reduced beyond what Insurance would like. Also, if we can improve the coverage.
- There is a need to make repairs in the Narthex/Garden room which includes replacing carpet and painting.
- We are addressing the parking problems at Picnic this year and the start time.

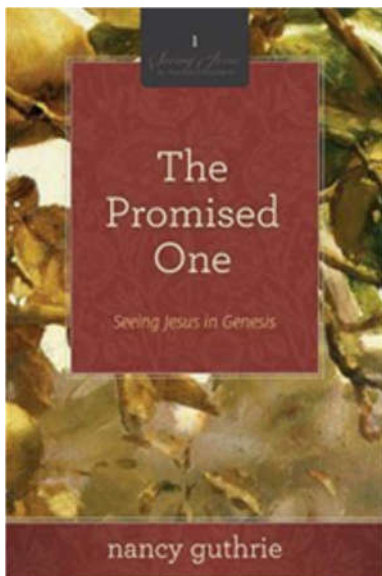

WOMEN'S FALL BIBLE STUDY Begins September 11, 9am to Noon

As we open up Genesis, we want to see Jesus. We want this study to enlarge our understanding and correct our misunderstanding about who He is and what his gospel is all about. Usually we don't turn to the Old Testament to see Jesus. Instead, we turn to the Gospels in the New Testament to see Him. Yet Jesus said to the Jewish leaders, "You search the scriptures because you think they give eternal life. But the scriptures point to me." (John 5:39) And, of course, the scriptures He was talking about were the books of the Old Testament. Jesus himself made it clear that we can search the Old Testament scriptures and find him there. This study is uniquely designed to help you to look in the wonder of the first book of the Old Testament – Genesis – and see how it prepares for and points us to Christ.

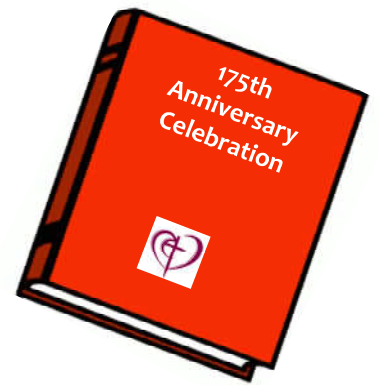

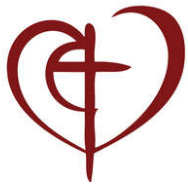
