White Cross News (Formerly Known As Stitch In)

Stitch In has changed its name to better describe the nature of our ministry and work. We still construct dresses and shorts for orphans in the Congo. We have increased our work to make many more items for the hospital and all people living in the small village of Tandala.

We are pleased to announce that our White Cross Ministry Group has filled two totes with necessary items for the orphans and adults in Congo, Tandala. They were delivered to the Congolese shipper in Paletine, IL the last weekend of October. We were able to send one hundred and fifty pounds of necessary items that included: 50 dresses, 7 pair of shorts, 18 Love Kits, 18 Love Kits, 3 Short sewing kits, 17 pair of shoes, 10 Book bag sewing kits, 8 pounds of homemade soap, (items for hospital use) 59 rolled bandages, 14 hemmed linens, and 6 cotton dressings. We would not have been able to prepare these items without the help of you, the congregation. Thank You for giving us the support to do this. These ladies that work at preparing these items receive a sense of joy and satisfaction in doing this work.

We are continuing to prepare for our next shipment which we hope and plan to be ready sometime in the summer of 2020. We hope you will continue you to support us so that we will be able to continue to send the much needed items.

To replenish the items, we will need; used Cotton bedsheets and Cotton quilt backing remnants to use for hospital bandages and hemmed linens. We are always looking for pretty Cotton prints to make dresses or shorts for the children that are orphaned. We will let you know in the future our needs for the Love and Mercy Kits. Again, Thank You all that have helped us make this ministry possible.

We are always welcome new hearts and hands to join us! We construct dresses and shorts, tearing and rolling bandages and hemming hospital lines. If you don't like to sew, we have other tasks available. We can supply you with all the necessary supplies to work at home or you may enjoy joining us on our work days. We have a good time, however, we will not meet for the months of November and December. Fall In-Gathering:

November 13th will be Women's Fellowship's fall "In-Gathering" supporting **Nurses for Newborns**. This is a home visitation program which provides a safety net for families to prevent infant mortality, child abuse, and neglect. Specially trained pediatric nurses are sent to the homes of pregnant women or parents with infants who face medical, social or environmental risks. There will be a collection box in the Welcome Center, beginning October 9th to place your donations. New or gently used items needed: infant clothing newborn to 2T, receiving blankets, bibs, wash cloths, bath towels, board books etc. New baby care items needed: lotions, bottles, bottle brushes, pacifiers, etc. Especially needed are diapers (all sizes) and wipes (unscented preferred).
