

January Meeting with Missionaries John and Melissa Shehan, and a Baby Shower!


The January snowstorm wreaked havoc in many ways, including canceling our planned update from John and Melissa Shehan after the worship service on January 5th. We were disappointed that the entire congregation did not have the opportunity to hear from them, but the Mission Team was able to meet with John and Melissa virtually on January 6th. The couple is currently home from Mozambique on their normal winter visit, but this year their time in the US will be extended to the summer because they are due to have a baby boy in March! John and Melissa had a focus in 2024 on discipleship training for local pastors and leaders in the region of their base in Nacala. There were no churches in the area when John and Melissa came to Mozambique, but now there are dozens. The area is predominantly Muslim, but the people are responding to the Gospel! The common comment is, "We have never heard about Jesus!" The people are hungry for the Word, and solar audio Bibles in the native language are paying great dividends. John often shares God's plan for salvation with workers on the various construction projects he manages.

You will recall that John and Melissa have been building a house for themselves in Nacala. They were happy to report that the walls are up and a temporary roof was added before they left the country. Their hope is it will only take 3 or 4 more months after their return to complete their new home. Because of the heavy rain in the area, everything is built from concrete. The roof will be metal. It will be wonderful to have their own home with the new baby!

Speaking of the Shehan baby, it was wonderful that Sieglinde Schnellbacher was able to host a lovely baby shower at her home on January 9th, in place of the shower originally planned by the Mission Team, but canceled due to the snowstorm. Melissa and her Mom, Joan Knappenberger, were able to attend. The baby was outfitted with a number of needed items, including a beautiful handmade quilt courtesy of the St. Paul's Quilters.

Please continue to pray for John and Melissa. They are on the front-line of sharing the Gospel in an area where extremists do not appreciate Christians. Currently the government of Mozambique is in turmoil due to a contentious national election. Pray that tensions will simmer down before John and Melissa return later this year. Also pray that the visa and passport process for the new baby will go smoothly.

We hope that John and Melissa will be able to visit St. Paul's and give everyone an update in a few months before their return to Mozambique (and we will get to meet that baby!)


